Empowering children in Walmer Township, near Port Elizabeth, South Africa

Founded in 2012 by Ellen and Chris, Heatherbank started life with 30 children in a modest cottage. It now has 13 classrooms, an ablution block, computer room, sick bay and a sports field.



Our donations have helped fund the development and building of the school, which is now giving 182 township children an education in English, along with a 'values program' in music, art and life skills.

From families with little education and, at best, low paid jobs, these children are now given this opportunity to get a heads up in life.

Their dream of progressing onto High School and Tertiary Education can become a reality.

Every year Holmewood children visit Heatherbank on their South Africa exchange. **They see a growing and thriving school.**
