

The Person

The successful candidate will be a self-starter, enthusiastic, motivated and happy to work independently or as part of a team. This role would suit someone with a natural friendliness integrating with staff, parents and children alike. The role is generally with one other to grown as you would like, there will be quiet times that you will be working independently. You will be given plenty of support when needed. The successful candidate will be subject to an enhanced DBS check.

Your role

The role is responsible for operating the school's coffee shop, term time only. It is a pleasant environment with a lovely atmosphere. You will be working alongside another, and training and support will be given.

Duties

The role is responsible for operating the School's coffee shop during the agreed hours. This includes:

- Taking orders, making drinks and providing food, managing payment process.
- Clearing and cleaning tables and making sure the coffee shop area is kept in a good state of cleanliness and tidiness during the opening hours.
- Manage both setup and close down operations for relevant sessions when the shop is open.

Hours of work

The available role is for 4 hours a week, on Mondays 2pm – 6pm (term time only). The school shop operates 5 days per week, so there may be opportunities to cover absence on other days.

Salary

The salary for this role will be £12.60 per hour.

Monday IIth November or as soon as possible thereafter.

Offer

The successful applicant will be offered the role subject to the satisfactory completion of a number of background checks including but not limited to; an enhanced DBS check, the taking up and verification of references, the verification of career history and fitness to undertake the role. The successful applicant must also have a driving licence.
